The KACAPN was founded as a nonprofit organization in February 2004 by a group of professional Korean-American Artists.

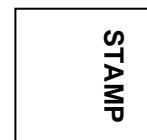
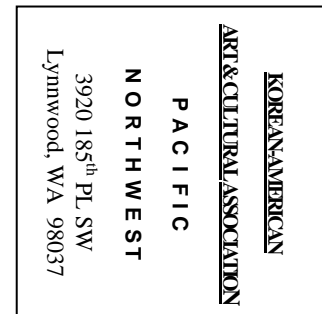
Our Mission:
